

UFU TO TAKE AUXILARY CONCERNS TO INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION

Despite your union's persistence, QFRS have not responded to the UFUQ interim proposal that hourly rates and Captain's allowance be increased, that minimum payments for work on weekends and public holidays be implemented, that a pager on-call allowance be introduced, that increased superannuation payments be phased in, and that negotiations for an auxiliaries' certified agreement commence from 1 September 2012.

Despite our numerous attempts, QFRS have not agreed to progress negotiations for an auxiliary certified agreement.

On that basis your union has sought the assistance of the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission. UFUQ notified QIRC on 7/9/12 of a 'breakdown in negotiations' and have ask the commission to preside over a conference of the parties . You will be advised of any progress in the QIRC.
