

State Committee of Management (SCM) meets to discuss

Enterprise Bargaining talks

Your Union's SCM met this week, and discussed the current situation regarding enterprise bargaining negotiations.

The negotiations have been subject to conciliation conferences in the Queensland Industrial Relations Commission (QIRC) over recent weeks.

During the conferences Queensland Fire and Rescue Service (QFRS) and the government modified some of their demands and addressed some of your concerns about a number of government claims.

SCM believes there remains scope to reach an agreement with further negotiations but currently hold reservations about the overall package being proposed, the cumulative extent of change being sought by QFRS, and limited benefits being offered to UFU members.

Your union will raise SCM concerns with QFRS next week.
